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## Notice of Court Case To Proceed

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The Accused and the Accuser are hereby lawfully noticed that the MBA – LS Secretary has set the date and time at which a lawful proceeding can be scheduled to settle the matter of the dispute between the accuser and the accused as above.

The Accuser and Accused are invited to attend this court proceeding to peacefully, lawfully, and justly settle the matter under dispute as per the documents that have been served on the Accused, provided by the Accuser.

The Accuser is lawfully noticed of the following points.

1. Burden of proof rests with the accuser.  
Your documents will be passed to the Jury at the beginning of the case.

Reading time of documents is a part of your case time.

Should you have any more evidence you are advised to bring any and all evidence you have with you on the day so that you can present it to the jury. This includes any witnesses or any character referees you wish to bring with you.

2. Should you have gained any new evidence since the time of submitting your case you are advised to make it available to both the MBA – LS Secretary and the accused.

The normal 14 copies need to be provided.

3. You are advised that the Jury will be instructed to take a dim view on “surprise” evidence. You are expected to be open and honest about your evidence to give the accused every chance to defend him/herself should the man/woman actually be innocent.

4. You are advised that the presumption of innocence is in operation until a guilty verdict is reached.

If an innocent verdict is reached then compensation will be due to the accused for time and trouble. That compensation will be paid by you.

5. On the day of the court proceeding you may be required to give testimony under oath.

You may not decline this request.

The Accused is lawfully noticed of the following points.

1. You have the right to confront your accuser.  
Should you choose to waive this right then you will be judged guilty by non presentation.  
  
You are very well advised to accept this invitation to defend yourself against this allegation.
2. You have the right to send a delegate in your place. However this is not highly recommended.
3. You have the right to have an advisor with you in the court proceeding. The advisor is an advisor of your choice. The lawful name is a McKensie Friend. You may not pay this McKensie friend for his services.
4. You have the right, should you choose, to have a court appointed Association of the Mens Business Associate explain to you what ever it is you wish to have explained to you. You will be required to pay the fees for this mans time should you engage such an advisor.
5. On the day of the court proceeding you may be required to give testimony under oath.  
  
You may decline this request.
6. Should you be found guilty you will be held accountable for all court costs. The MBA Court will send Peace Officers to seize your property should you be unwilling to agree to pay the cost of court proceedings.
7. You are well advised that should you actually be guilty to admit this guilt and to make remedy to the Accuser.

Our courts have a good record of being fair and just and we believe that we rarely have a guilty party gain a false innocent and we have a very low number of innocent people subject to a false guilty verdict.
