Writ of Outlawry

Details of Writ of Outlawry

To all to whom this document may be presented.

You are hereby lawfully noticed that the outlaw by the calling xxxxxxxx has been tried fairly and justly in a court of law and is now considered an outlaw.

You are hereby lawfully noticed that due to this outlaw status that any other human being who assists this outlaw in any way, or provides services and support to this outlaw in any way, is also committing the crime of aiding and abetting a known outlaw.

This is a serious crime and you may be brought before a court of law to answer for any such crime.

You are hereby lawfully noticed that should you not follow the instructions of the Peace Officer who presents you with this Writ of Outlawry then you may be accused of obstructing a Peace Officer in the course of his duty.

This too is a serious crime for which you will be held accountable should you commit it.

It is recommended that should a Peace Officer of the Mens Business Association - Law Services present you with this Writ of Outlawry that you give him your full and immediate co-operation.

A Peace Officer of the Mens Business Association carries more lawful backing than any Police Officer.
